When arrival at Lisbon, it's time to a walking tour, around the downtown with a special glance at Praça do Comercio, Alfama and Sé.

Then we proceed by bus till Belem, the neighbourhood of the Discoveries, with the Belém Tower and the Jerónimos



Monastery, both World Heritage. But also with the original Coach Museum and the modern Belém Cultural Centre. Oh, and don't forget to taste the delicious cream pastries (custard tarts)!

Then the sun called for us, and we go in direction of one of the most popular beaches around Lisbon, Carcavelos.



With the São Julião da Barra Fort dominating at one end, Carcavelos Beach is the largest expanse of sand on the Estoril coast and regularly hosts beach volleyball and football competitions.



Given its proximity to Lisbon and easy means of access, Carcavelos Beach is highly popular during the summer while in winter it is mostly given over to the surfing and bodyboarding communities, brought in by the excellent conditions here.



Next to the Beach, there is a wide choice of renowned restaurants in addition to bars and terraces just perfect for some quality time in the sun.

26th OCTOBER - THURSDAY - OUREM

Breakfast at the hotel.

Today we suggest the visit of one of the oldest castles of Portugal.



At the top of a high hill, which was the ideal place for the building of a settlement in the old days, stands the older part of the town of Ourém, founded under the name of Abdegas. The Moorish occupation of the region from the 9th century onwards lies at the origin of the town's current name, reminding us of the story of the Moorish

maiden Fatima, who converted to Christianity because of her love for the Knight Templar Gonçalo Hermingues and thereafter adopted the name of Oureana.

In 1136, the town was conquered from the Moors by Dom Afonso Henriques, the first king of Portugal, who gave it to his daughter. Dona Teresa ordered the Castle to be built in 1178 and granted the town a charter in 1180.

Ourém Castle is one of Portugal's most innovative 15th century military architectural works. Commissioned by the Count of Ourém, the grandson of D. Nuno Álvares Pereira, the castle has a compact structure with modern active defensive system, including two large pentagonal towers that served as bulwarks and offered greater resistance to enemy fire.





Before driving back to Fatima for lunch, we can have a snack at one of the delicious coffees in Ourém.
